



AUDITION INFORMATION – Please read everything carefully (THERE ARE CHANGES)! We are excited to announce we are going to be performing "Guys & Dolls" for our Spring Musical on April 17th, 18th & 20th 2026!

This family friendly, award-winning classic gambles with luck and love under the bright lights of Broadway.

We are auditioning **ALL AGES** for the cast. *Registration fee is \$40, Non-refundable, for <u>all</u> cast members.* Everyone who auditions gets a part. Bring your whole family to audition for the cast or sign-up for production crew*!

*We also need Crew members who would prefer to not be on stage (you will still need to fill out the audition form to sign up for crew but you do not need to sign up for an audition time or pay the fee. You will be contacted at a later time to meet with the director.)

We plan to have a mandatory parent/cast meeting sometime during the week of December 29th and then regular rehearsals will start in January. Dress rehearsals the week of April 13th and Performances are MANDATORY.

Auditions will be held Fri Dec 12th from 4-7pm & Sat Dec 13th from 9am-Noon. Auditions will be held in small groups by appointment and will last 30 min. (Note: Up to 10 people may sign up for 1 time slot so you may be auditioning with other people.) They are held at 170 N Main in Nephi. Enter through the southeast glass door and go up the stairs to the left. PLEASE BE ON TIME.

<u>The 1st step</u> is to schedule your audition appointment. Please go to https://signup.com/go/XEXVtiB after you have finished reading all the information to begin the process.

<u>The 2nd step</u> is to complete the audition form online at https://forms.gle/pTx3rwzM8ryPz8vUA (After you book your appointment, there is also a link next to your time slot that will take you to this form.)

<u>The 3rd step</u> is to Pay the non-refundable \$40 Registration Fee for all participants auditioning to be in the cast by going to www.jfac.info and clicking the "donate" button OR venmo: michellebharris.

BEFORE YOU COME TO AUDITIONS! Be prepared with the following:

- 1) Complete all 3 steps above.
- 2) Bring the calendar on the next page with your scheduling conflicts written in for December 29th through April 18th 2026. THERE WILL NOT BE TIME DURING THE AUDITION FOR YOU TO FILL THIS OUT, SO PLEASE HAVE IT DONE BEFOREHAND. The calendar lists all the possible dates that we may schedule rehearsals. Please review this VERY CAREFULLY. We can work around PRE-APPROVED conflicts and ask that you let us know by filling out the calendar with any conflicts you have. You may only need to attend one or two rehearsals a week depending on your part. We go to great lengths to put together a rehearsal schedule that will work around everyone's schedules. We will try to accommodate the best we can so that you can attend all rehearsals for your part as well as follow through with any personal commitments and family life.
- 3) Prepare a SHORT musical selection to sing. Musical theater pieces are preferred but not required. (A piano & phone connectors will be provided for accompaniment if needed.)
- 4) Wear comfortable shoes and clothing and be prepared to learn a short dance number.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What if I don't have my full schedule through April yet, how do I fill out the conflict calendar?

A: Do your best to fill in everything you know about at this time. The rehearsal schedule will be published a month at a time so you will be able to add additional conflicts at the end of each month to be considered when creating the following month's schedule.

Q: What if I can't sing or dance? What if I have never acted on stage before?

A: That's ok! All are welcome! There are many roles in the show that don't require any singing or dancing and our mission is to provide participants with an education as well as a fun experience. As part of the process, participants receive instruction in Acting, Dancing, Singing, Theater Etiquette and Performance. Just make sure you let us know at auditions what you are comfortable doing. Also, consider being on the stage crew or volunteering to help with sets or costumes if that is more your speed.

Q: What about children 8 & under? Can they audition?

A: We do allow children 8 & under to audition. You are the best judge of whether your child would benefit from this experience. However, please take into consideration the following: 1) An adult must accompany them to ALL rehearsals and help the child to be engaged. There are certain circumstances where a child exhibits a level of maturity where they don't need an adult but we will make that determination and communicate with the parent if that is the case. 2) The child needs to be able to pay attention and focus for up to 30 minutes at rehearsal and up to 2 hours for dress rehearsal. While we try to make rehearsals as fun as possible and take breaks when necessary, some children find the process dull at times and need to be able to persist and push through.

Q: If my child wants to audition, do I have to audition as well?

A: No, but it is a lot of fun to do a show as a family! Also keep in mind there are other ways to be involved such as taking tickets for the performances, sewing costumes, and helping with sets. Just let us know that you are interested in helping and we will contact you.

Q: What if I want to audition but none of the audition times work for me?

A: Contact us and we will work something out. We want to give everyone the opportunity to participate.

Q: Why do we have to pay a registration fee?

A: Unfortunately we have had to implement a small registration fee to cover some of the costs associated with producing a show of this magnitude. If you are uneasy about this, please take into account all the wonderful things you get in return. Participants receive instruction in Acting, Dancing, Singing, Theater Etiquette and Performance. And above all, you really can't put a price on the friendships you will make!

Q: What are some of the costs I may be required to cover in addition to the registration fee?

A: We try to provide as much as we can. However, as outlined in the agreement during registration, you may be required to provide parts of your own costume (shoes and your base clothing for example are not provided due to various sizing issues). You may also be responsible for any costs associated with printing your script or paying for damages to scripts that must be returned to the royalty company. You will also need to provide your own makeup, hairspray, etc. for the performances. As always, if you need help with any costs, please let us know so we can work with you.

Q: What if an emergency comes up unexpectedly that prevents me from being able to attend rehearsals or performances?

A: Let us know immediately. While we may not be able to resolve every conflict, as long as we know about it ahead of time, we can usually come up with a solution so you can still attend Aunt Edna's funeral.

Q: What if I need a ride to the auditorium?

A: Let us know. We will try to find someone to pick you up.

Q: What if I am in witness protection? Will I be recorded?

A: When you register with us, you agree to give your consent for photos and/or video to be taken and used for promotional purposes or social media. If you really don't want to be photographed or recorded, please let us know.
